## “Fathead” Headlines Five Marquis Acts at 2009 Unionville Village Festival

Five high-profile and successful Canadian musical acts will perform at Unionville’s first-ever staged “Concert in Crosby Park” on Saturday, June 6, 2009, starting at 1 p.m.

- **Fathead** – These double JUNO-winners have played the top blues rooms, concert halls and music festivals from coast to coast. Their music is steeped heavily in the blues, married with elements of R&B, funk and soul, and possesses a unique ensemble sound that is immediately recognizable as their own.
- **Mob Barley and the Railers** – This Bob Marley tribute band was started by Mista D (singer for The Salads) and Matty (singer for Dodger) as a fun, cover-band project and quickly grew into an in-demand act that captures the soul of reggae.
- **Northern Harbour** – One of the finest and most authentic tribute bands to Jimmy Buffett, its veteran musicians have performed with Chris De Burgh, Supertramp, Billy Joel, Ronnie Hawkins and The Stampeders as well as Jimmy himself.
- **Bingham Loop** – Popular throughout the GTA and beyond and led by a dynamic female singer, this band’s approach to cover rock gets people up and dancing.
- **Cobra Kings** – The Markham-based band performs classic R&B, classic rock, soul, reggae and modern blues with authenticity and passion, and is just about to release its first album.
