



It's that time of year! The 49<sup>th</sup> annual Unionville Festival will be happening June 2 and 3. We look forward to again welcoming thousands of visitors from near and far to enjoy the annual Saturday morning parade, food and shopping on Main Street, music and theatrical performances, fireworks at Toogood Pond as well as Sunday's Fun Run, Family Day in Crosby Park, treasure hunt, over 150 vendor booths and much more.

As a resident in the immediate vicinity, please note the following street closures that may affect you during the Festival. Watch for signs on the streets as well.

## **Street Closures and Access Limitations**

### **Saturday June 2 - 8 am to Midnight:**

- Main Street from Library Lane to Pavillion (to Euclid after the parade and to Fred Varley after 6:30 pm)
- Carlton Road from Pomander to Chambery (to Concession after 6:30 pm)
- Victoria Avenue (Residents may park on Victoria east of Bruce Creek. Access from Berkley Court.) (Reopening at 6:30 pm)
- Controlled access: The Concession Road (parking east of Main Street) from Carlton Road. (No access to the Concession Road from Main Street until 6:30 pm.)

### **Limited access for local residents and guests only:**

- Main Street from the Bridal Trail to Carlton Road
- Main Street from the railway tracks to Pavillion Street
- Maple Lane
- Eckardt Avenue

Note that access to the streets above will be closed completely for brief periods between 9 am and 11:30 am. for the parade.

- Fred Varley Drive from Fonthill Drive to Main Street
- E.J. Lennox Way



## **Street Closures and Access Limitations**

### **Sunday June 3: 7 am to 6:30 pm:**

- Main Street from Carlton Road to the railroad tracks
- Victoria Avenue

Roads will be open from 10 am to 11 am for vendors to set up

### **For the Fun Run, 8 am to 9 am**

#### **Limited access for residents and guests only:**

- Main Street from the railway tracks to Pavillion Street
- Eckardt Avenue

Please be prepared for minor delays to allow runners to pass safely.

**Please follow the directions of the run volunteers.**

**Throughout the festival please follow the directions of Festival volunteers, security guards and police.**
